Rules, Regulations and Conditions of Competition

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF/CHJA/CHSA/NEHC rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Mystic Valley Hunt Club, Inc. the owners, the show, the officials and employees will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show.

The USEF Non-Member fee for juniors and seniors is \$20.

Every class offered herein which is recognized by the NEHC, CHJA & CHSA will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current rules. In order to compete for NEHC, CHJA & CHSA annual horse awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the respective organization and the horse or pony must be registered with the respective organization. To show in NEHC and CHJA Medal classes, riders MUST be members. A copy of the CHJA Rule Book, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office and at www.chja.net<<http://www.chja.net/>>, and www.vthorse.com/nehc/.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to and arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, its decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section, or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Management reserves the right to split or combine classes or divisions as it determines entries warrant, while maintaining minimal USEF requirements to fill a class.

GENERAL INFORMATION

In accordance with GR901.29, minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheel-chairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Judging System: This horse show will be using a numerical system of judging.

ENTRY CLOSING: Entries for the Mystic Summer Festival must be postmarked by August 28, 2008. **STALL RESERVATIONS MUST BY RECEIVED BY AUGUST 23, 2008.**

ENTRIES: No entry will be accepted or recorded unless signed by the owner/rider/ trainer, contain all USEF membership & recording numbers and the required fees in U.S. funds accompany the entry blank. To speed processing, send a copy of your measurement card and USEF membership card with your entry. All hunter divisions, jumper divisions and/or equitation divisions may, at the discretion of management, be limited in number of entries to conform to a time schedule. In such cases, entries will be selected on a first come first serve basis. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to mail in a complete entry with payment. **\$30 office fee per entry.**

Jumper nomination fee of \$75 for entries in the Marshall & Sterling Jumper Classics, Junior/A/O, Open must be paid by closing date or will be assessed a \$25 penalty. All jumpers must be declared within one hour of the last class of the day prior to showing to avoid the \$25 penalty fee.

POST ENTRIES: Entries received after the closing date will be assessed a \$25.00 fee. USEF Rule GR 901 4. When a Licensed competition does accept post entries it must be stated in the prize list and post entries can only be accepted prior to the starting of the class and upon signature of exhibitor or his agent and trainer.

SCRATCH/REFUND: Once entered, no horse may be scratched without a veterinarian's certificate. In the case of illness or injury before the start of the show, the certificate must be received by the Horse Show Secretary prior to 8:00 a.m. on the opening date of the show in order to be eligible for a refund. Scratches during the show may be made only with a veterinarian's certificate signed by the Horse Show Veterinarian

and presented to the Horse Show Secretary before the start of the class the horse has been entered in. Refunds will be mailed within 30 days after the completion of the final class of the horse show. There will be a \$25 office fee for the excused scratches only. There will be no refunds due to severe weather or other emergency.

Please realize that you need to enter classes before they start.

STALLS: STALL RESERVATIONS MUST BE PAID IN FULL BY AUGUST 23, 2008. Stalls are approximately 10' X 10' All stalls will have doors. No initial bedding will be provided. **STALLS ARE NONREFUNDABLE and MUST be paid for in advance.** There will be no exceptions. Stalls will not be confirmed without payment. Stall fee is \$175. Wednesday – Monday. Stalls are temporary under tent and in indoor arena.

PRIZE MONEY will be distributed at the secretary's office and all checks will be void after 60 days from horse show conclusion.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be charged a \$25 penalty or 10% of the check, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given 3 days to make full payment, including the penalty, which may be paid by certified funds, cashier's check or money order. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification of the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.

LEASH LAW: All dogs to be leashed at all times. Please keep them safe.

MEASUREMENT CARDS: Owners of all pony and junior hunters must possess an USEF measurement card. These cards must be presented to the Horse Show Secretary before the start of their respective divisions.

AMATEUR CREDENTIALS: All Amateur-Owner and Adult Amateurs must present their USEF cards to the Horse Show Secretary before the start of the show.

DAMAGES: All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE: Horses may arrive no sooner than 9 a.m. on 9/3 and leave no later than noon on 9/8. Please contact horse show in advance if you need to make special arrangements.

RING DIMENSIONS: Main Hunter Ring – sand footing 125X240, **sand** warm-up; Hunter Annex - 115x240 with sand warm-up; Children's Ring 100x200 – sand with sand warm-up. **SAND** Jumper Field 325X225 with grass and sand warm-up. **Please note addition of all weather jumper ring and main hunter warm up ring footing!!**

Jumper Class orders will be a sign up EXCEPT for Classics. A posted jump order for all Classics will be up at least one hour prior to the start of the class. Late adds will be put at the beginning of the jumping order.

In the Jumper Ring, ties for other than first place will be broken by time taken to complete first round course.

Hunter Champion and Reserve Champion: To be awarded to two of the four horses scoring the most points over fences. In addition, only these will receive full points for ribbons won under saddle and half points for ribbons won in the model.

All Classes: Entry Fee \$30 unless otherwise stated.

Management reserves the right to limit the courtesy circle in fence classes. Each class will be awarded a trophy and eight ribbons. CHJA, CHSA

Management reserves the right to limit the courtesy circle in Hunter Classes. Eight ribbons will be awarded in all classes. In each division, championship will be awarded according to USEF rules. Unless otherwise stated, all hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness. The second class in each division, where applicable, will be the designated Marshall & Sterling class.

The champion and reserve champion title are awarded to the top two of the four horses that acquire the most points performing over a regulation course with obstacles at the full height required in the section in which shown, except under the provisions of the HU112.1 and .2. In addition to these points, only these four horses receive half points for ribbons won in model classes (full points for Regular Conformation Model classes) and full points for ribbons won in one Under Saddle class.

Riders may be tested. Riders may be asked questions on fundamentals of horsemanship.

278. Junior Equitation Medal 50% fences/50% flat Open to junior riders who have not competed over fences exceeding 3' in height. In the fences phase, riders will be asked to jump a maximum of 8 fences not to exceed 3' in height. In the flat phase, riders will show at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Riders may be tested. Riders may be asked questions on fundamentals of horsemanship

279. Adult Equitation Medal 50% fences/50% flat Open to adult riders who have not competed over fences exceeding 3' in height. 280. Pleasure Horse Medal Open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes, with no limitations as to status of rider. Riders will show at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Riders may be tested. Horses will be judged on manners, suitability, performance, quality, presence, substance, and soundness.

281. Pleasure Pony Medal Open to all ponies of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes, with no limitations as to status of rider. Riders will show at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Riders may be tested. Horses will be judged on manners, suitability, performance, quality, presence, substance, and soundness.

282. Pro-Am Medal Open to junior, adult amateur/professional combinations. Professional riders will be asked to jump a maximum of 8 fences not to exceed 2'6" in height. Immediately following the pro round, the junior/adult amateur rider will be asked to jump the same course on the same horse or pony. The scores will be added together to determine the winning combination. Professionals are not limited to the number of entries.
