Enter the fascinating world of horses this summer by joining Mystic Valley Hunt Club Inc.'s day camp. Our program is specifically designed for girls and boys ages 8-16 and runs weekly, Monday through Friday. Whether a complete beginner or a polished show rider, we can help you learn about horses. On our 172 acre farm, we provide horses and ponies just for people to learn on. We also have enough stalls to board any camper's private horse.

Beginners will learn the fundamentals of horse care and the basics of English riding. Intermediate and Advanced riders will learn the skills they need to further their riding education.

Riders are grouped according to ability. Since each session is limited to twelve riders, early sign-up is encouraged. Running from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., riders will spend the early hours in the saddle learning about hunt seat equitation. After a light snack (provided), the remaining time is spent in unmounted instruction. Weather presents no problem with our two large indoor arenas.

Proper attire: every student should wear close fitting pants, i.e. jeans, riding breeches if possible, a hard-soled shoe with a heel (sneakers not allowed), and a well fitting hunt cap. ASTM approved safety helmets are available for use.

The cost of regular camp is \$275, and advanced camp is \$400. Please complete the registration form and return with a \$25 deposit to the address below. (The deposit is non-refundable but applicable to the fee.)
